

## UMC Utrecht data access license

This data sharing license is only suitable for sharing research (meta) data which:

- (i) does not contain personal data,
- (ii) is not "owned" by third parties,
- (iii) is not generated within a research project/collaboration with third parties and
- (iv) is not considered valuable for UMC Utrecht.

By downloading/receiving access to the research data to which this license applies, you agree with the following provisions.

1. You will handle all data in accordance with applicable laws and you will keep the data confidential.
2. You will only use the data for academic research purposes. The data may never be used for commercial purposes. The data may not be used to improve algorithms or the like for commercial purposes.
3. The data may not be shared with third parties. You will refer third parties to UMC Utrecht to request a separate license to use the data.
4. You may transfer the data to academic third parties solely for the purpose of replication of the your research, in conformance with this license.
5. You will inform your contact point at UMC Utrecht from who you received the data of all results generated through use of the data. You hereby grant UMC Utrecht a non-exclusive, royalty free, perpetual license to use all such results directly generated by use of the data for academic research and education purposes.
6. It is expressly understood that UMC Utrecht does not make any warranties regarding the data and specifically does not warrant or guarantee that the data will be accurate, be merchantable or useful for any particular purpose. Use of the data is at your own risk. UMC Utrecht cannot and shall not be held liable for any claims or damages by you or any third party, in connection with or as a result of the use of data by you. Unless and to the extent caused by UMC Utrecht's gross negligence or willful misconduct, you will hold harmless UMC Utrecht at all times against all of such damages or claims.
7. Parties acknowledge the importance of disseminating the results of your research. Therefore, you shall endeavor to publish or otherwise publicly disclose information, any data, results or information generated using the data. The following shall apply to such disclosures:
  - a. Authorship of any publications shall follow the principles set out in the ICMJE recommendations 'Defining the Role of Authors and Contributors' as can be found on <http://www.icmje.org/recommendations/browse/roles-and-responsibilities/defining-the-role-of-authors-and-contributors.html>.
  - b. In every disclosure by you based upon results obtained from the research through the help of the received data provided by UMC Utrecht, you shall appropriately acknowledge UMC Utrecht as contributor of the data: "*We acknowledge the contribution by the UMC Utrecht for the data on '[name of dataset]' (DOI: [doi]) which has been downloaded from [link to source].*"
8. This license will be construed, governed, interpreted and enforced according to the laws of the Netherlands. All disputes arising out of or in relation to this Agreement that cannot be settled amicably will be brought before the competent courts of Midden-Nederland, location Utrecht, the Netherlands.
