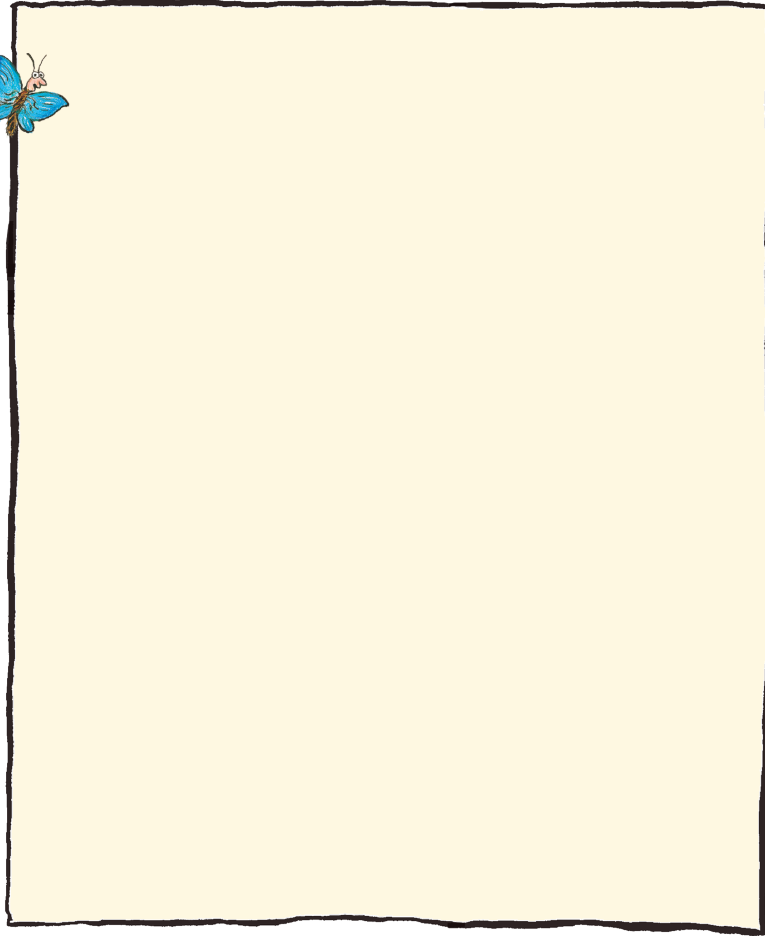

Take a look around you and see what you can use to create some wonderful woodland art. You can leave your picture on the floor for other Gruffalo Nature Explorers to discover!





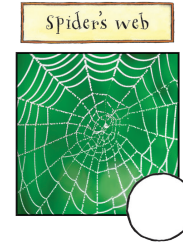
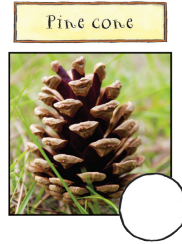
