What the Ladybird Heard of at CHRISTMAS

JULIA DONALDSON & LYDIA MONKS

Ask an adult for help with the scissors!

You will need:

- A sheet of card
- Scissors and something sharp to poke a hole!
- Something to colour in with
- Glue
- String

Make your very own ladybird Christmas decoration!

- 1. Cut out the wings and body below by following the dotted lines and stick them onto some card - then cut both shapes out of the card.
- 2. Colour both sides of the ladybird's body in black and her wings in red. Don't forget to add black spots to her wings!
- 3. Ask an adult to help make the hole on the ladybird's back to add your string through later.
- 4. Fold the wings! First, fold along the red line so the wings are folded in half.

- 5.Then fold along both yellow lines to open the wings out in the opposite direction.
- 6. Add some glue to the inside of the ladybird's wings along the red line fold.
- 7. Position the ladybird's head between the wings before pinching both of the sticky sides together.
- 8. And finally, thread your string through the hole and you've made your ladybird decoration!
