

## Make Your Own Favourite Book


Have a go at making your own book, using the 'My Favourite Book' template! What story will you tell?



STEP 1: Take your sheet of paper and fold it in half lengthways along the blue line.



STEP 2: Fold it in half again along the red line.




STEP 3: Fold it in half again along the green line. Now you should have a small folded rectangle of paper.




STEP 4: Unfold the page and there should be eight sections within your fold lines.



STEP 5: Fold your page again along the red line.




STEP 6: Make a mark in the middle of your rectangle (at the meeting point of the red and green lines).




STEP 7. Ask a grown-up to cut along the blue line, from the folded edge of your page to this mark. Stop cutting at the dot!







STEP 8: Unfold your page and you should have a slit in the middle. Fold your page again along the blue line.




STEP 9: Push the folded edges together towards the centre so that the slit opens up and creates a diamond shape in the middle. Keep pushing the edges closer together until the sides all meet in the middle.




STEP 10: Take the side that says 'My Favourite Book' and fold it around until it joins the other rectangles. This is now the front of your book.



STEP 11: Take the side that says 'The End' and fold it around until it joins the other rectangles. This is now the back of your book.



STEP 12: Press over the creases to make the spine of your book. Now you can get writing!
