How to Draw Charlie Cook


Look at the pictures below to learn how to draw Charlie Cook.
Trace the grey lines to practise as you go.



1 Start by drawing the nose.
Then add a smiley mouth
and a square chin.

2 Add the face. Draw eyes,
eyebrows and a small
C-shaped ear.


3 Draw Charlie's hair. Use
lots of little lines going in
different directions.




4 Draw Charlie's neck, shoulder
and back. Add a line for the
bottom of his shirt.


5 Add Charlie's arm. Draw a
little line up from the bottom
of the shirt.

6 Now draw the legs. Draw
them bent and at an angle
to look like he's walking.





7 Draw a rectangle at the end of each leg and two shoes. Don't forget to add the soles.




8 Draw the hands. This is tricky! Start with the thumb. Charlie will be holding books.




9 Add a stack of books balancing on the hands you drew in step 8.



10 Finally, add details. Draw shoelaces, trouser stitching and book titles.






A Cosy Armchair





